How to move forward with the purchase

With the approval of the the Council, Downtown Seniors will communicate with FOPAR the desire of the SCCSC Council for a laptop cart and request the necessary funds to purchase said cart.

Purpose

The laptop cart is a fundamental piece of equipment that is necessary for the operation of the SCCSC lab. Downtown Seniors acquired twelve laptops, six Macbook airs and six Windows machines, to replace the old desktops that once lived in the Senior Lounge. The current solution for the storage of the laptops is an old cabinet that requires the laptops to be stacked on one another, overtime this will lead to broken, bent, and scratched laptops. With the introduction of a laptop charging cart we can not only properly store laptops in a way that prevents damage, but also allow easy charging and transportation. Without this cart the SCCSC cannot operate at even a quarter of what it did when having a fully functioning lab. Thorough research has been conducted to find the cart that most suits the needs of the SCCSC, and I have concluded that this cart will properly fulfill all the described needs above.
